The Winemaking

Destemmed to an open-top tank for fermentation and gently hand plunged two to three times daily. Pressed directly to oak with 3 weeks barrel fermentation followed by 10 months maturation - 60% French, 40% American, with 20% new oak. Unfined, unfiltered and vegan. Bottled 2nd February 2015 - 1,794 bottles, 149 doz

The Wine

Polished, precise and all things nice. Typically Ebenezer, dense, dark and packed full of flavour, with cardamom spice and sweet fruit. The wine from the ancient gnarly rocks and vibrant orange clays yields blackcurrant and cranberry fruit with notes of leather and blackberry jam. It finishes with power and earth. Drinking...Ready to drink upon release or cellar to 2034. Alcohol 14% alc/vol
