

CRFT 2021 Pinot Noir The Scanlon Vineyard - Piccadilly Valley

Made by wife-and-husband winemakers Candice Helbig and Frewin Ries, CRFT Wines specialises in small-batch, single-vineyard wines.

Each CRFT wine is made with grapes picked from a single vineyard, and every bottle becomes a reflection of place - a story of site, soil and season.

We source fruit from a handful of vineyards across the Adelaide Hills and Barossa Valley, including our own NASAA Certified Organic Adelaide Hills vineyard - named Arranmore.



The Wine

Packed with red berries, strawberries and cream it's bright and fresh with a soft supple palate and warm spice.

Drink now or cellar carefully for 5 years.

The Winemaking

Hand-made at CRFT Carey Gully winery. 100% Piccadilly Valley Pinot Noir, hand-picked on $24^{\rm th}$ March 2021. Cold soaked followed by wild fermentation in an open-top tank with 25% whole bunch. Pressed to barrel once dry for wild malolactic fermentation and maturation. Occasional battonage. Matured for 9 months in 100% French oak, 40% 1 year old. Bottled $24^{\rm th}$ January 2022.

Vineyard: Owned and farmed by Justin Scanlon with his son Harry.
